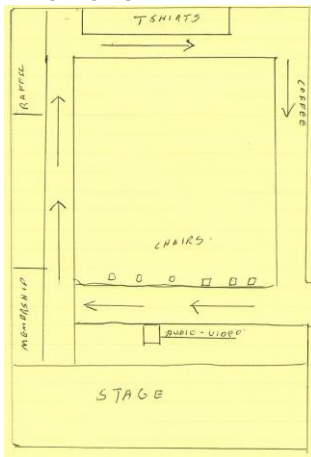
SIGN IN PROCEDURE AT MEETINGS

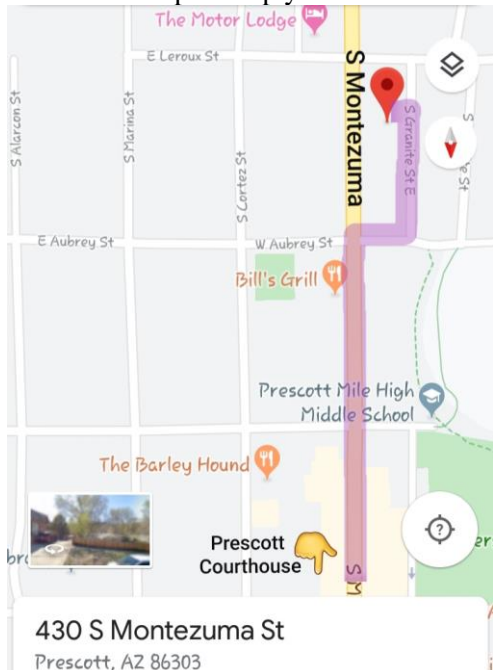

FIELD TRIP REPORT

The trip for calcite was a huge success- except for a flat tire (sorry, Mike)!! We had over 40 people, and more than 20 vehicles. The finding was easy, thanks to George and Sharon Lane. And, parts of an old car were found, along with a very nice crucible!

Our next trip will be to Red Cloud (wulfenite) and Geronimo (vanadinite) mine, because several people have not yet gone, and others want to go again. Mark your calendars for March 21, ***we will meet at Red Cloud Mine Road and Lake Martinez road, at 8:00 A.M. and leave for the mines at 8:30.*** 4x4 is highly recommended, but the mine operator gets in with 2WD. You can stay at the mine overnight. It was \$25 for each mine last time- actually, we did both mines in one day for the \$25. It all depends on the operator. Lighted hard hats, and a chisel and sledge are needed for Geronimo- it is an iron ladder straight down a steel culvert for 40 feet, then a sloped ladder for another 70 feet or so. Paper or other masks would be good. Backpacks. The Red Cloud is an open pit mine (hard hats required), down a fairly steep slope. AND there is a raffle with your paid admission! Don't forget your blacklights for some GREAT nighttime florescent hunting.

April, if not too warm, will be a road trip to just north of the Cave Creek area for some gorgeous and abundant red and multi color jasper. 2 WD will get you there, ***4x4 if you want to continue on to the Bloody Basin road, but that will NOT be a part of the Club Trip.***
